

Environmental Policy

1. Systematically apply the principles of sustainable development in planning, design, construction, operation and decommissioning of facilities, systems and services;
2. Leading change processes with employees and partners of activity in order to obtain environmental improvements, through concerted action and effective communication of the policy and objectives of ANA in this area;
3. Develop management systems in this matter and involving all employees to ensure that the environmental factors are included and weighted in the analysis leading to decision making;
4. Establish an open and frank dialogue with the surrounding communities and others affected by the environmental impact of our activities, seeking and discussing solutions to examine the feasibility and socio-economic balance of the development of the activity;
5. Continually improve our environmental performance as a whole, making comparisons with similar situations, with the ambitious goals set by promoting the annual audit and reporting of the results achieved and allocating the necessary financial resources;
6. Ensure compliance with environmental legislation as a goal and minimum provision required.

Priority areas of action of ANA, SA, adapted to the situation at each local include the adoption of oriented strategies to:

- Energy efficiency, monitoring and reducing emissions of greenhouse gases;
- Monitoring and minimization of water consumption;
- Control of emissions potentially pollutant for the air, soil and water resources.
- Promoting the reduction, reuse and recycling of waste;
- Noise management;
- Preservation of biodiversity.

The priorities and objectives will be regularly defined, reviewed and updated in the face of changing circumstances and the results achieved.
