

STATEMENT⁽¹⁾

ANA Aeroportos de Portugal, SA, hereinafter referred to as ANA, hereby represented by Thierry Franck Dominique Ligonnière and Alexandre Boris Georges Victor Lapeyre, in their capacity as Chairman of the Executive Committee and member of the Executive Committee, hereby attest that the company recognises the urgency of the climate crisis and the need for immediate, ambitious and sustained action. In this context, we reaffirm ANA's commitment to the global goal of limiting the increase in the planet's average temperature to 1.5°C, in line with the Paris Agreement.

To this end, decarbonisation goals are assumed to ensure that, by 2030, the 10 airports managed by ANA are:

- NetZero;
- Accredited at the highest level of Airport Carbon Accreditation (ACA).

Thus, for all Airports that are accredited at Level 5, ANA certifies that:

- It has managed to reduce the airport's carbon footprint (scopes 1 and 2) by 90% or more (compared to 2014) and will ensure that this reduction will be maintained;
- It is committed to reducing scope 3 emissions, in line with the ISO Net Zero target and the aviation sector commitments/ framework.
